Types of Activities:

<u>Outreach Activity (column 1)</u> = Conference sessions, workshops, speaking engagements, program events about ARISS with audiences. In-person or virtual. If you had a conference booth that was not part of a Space Station Explorers booth, estimate those who actually visited your booth.

<u>ISS Experiment Activity (column 2)</u> = Students who directly control, contribute to, or participate in ISS-based experiments other than the ARISS contact. (When reporting data on your ARISS contact, use the ARISS Activity Report.)

<u>Learning Activity (column 3)</u> = STEM-related and ARISS-related activities done with students—do not include ISS-based experiments that are listed in counted (see above). Do not include ARISS contacts—for those, use the ARISS Activity Report. Do include in-person or virtual lessons. Example: students watching how to make satellite contacts, listening to ARISS contacts

<u>Professional Development Activity for Educators (column 4)</u> = Educator training, teach-ins, etc. (in person or virtual) about aspects of ARISS. If you train teachers on how to use your ISS-related program, include their students if you can reasonably estimate them.
